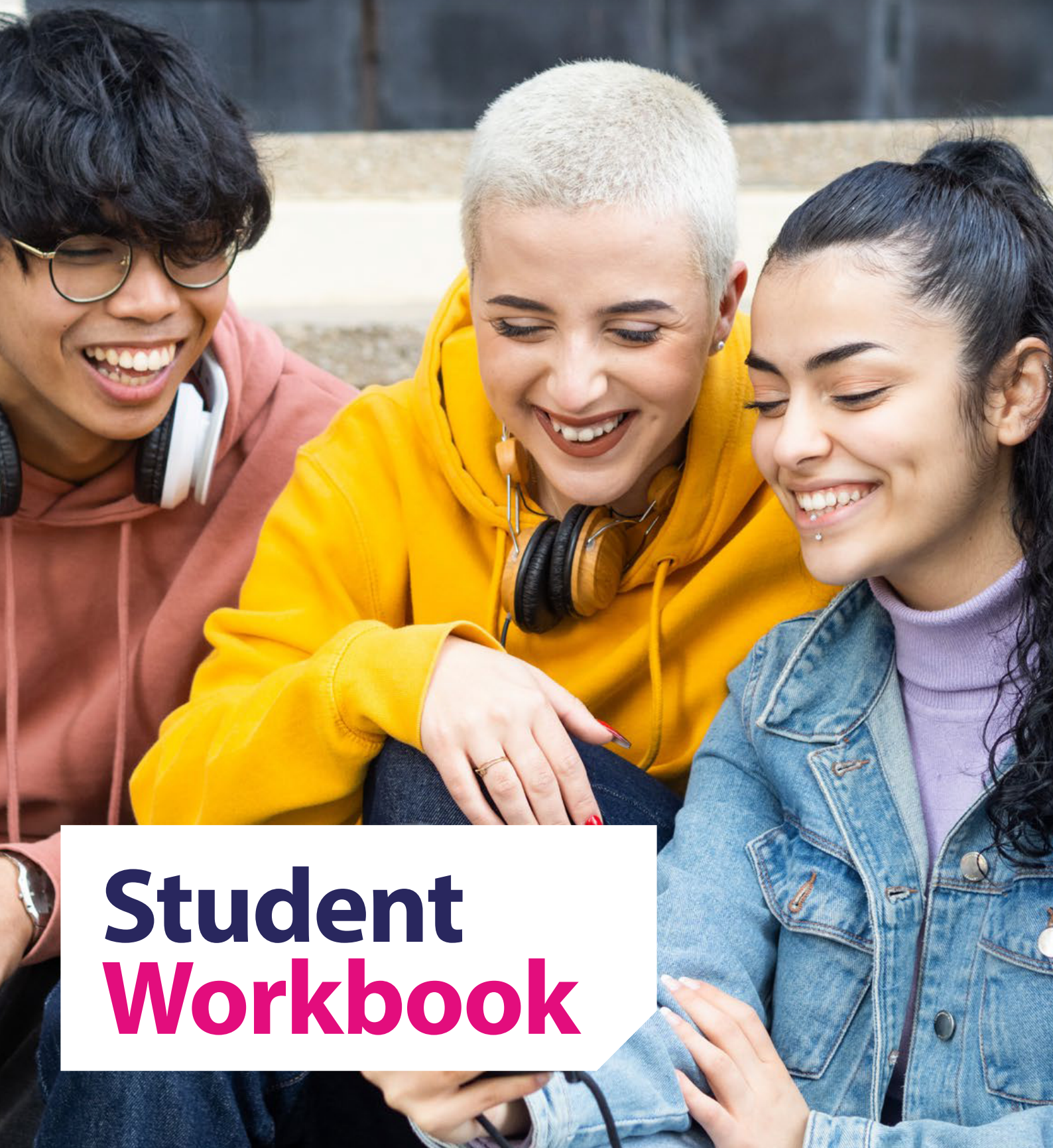

# Next Steps

Now that you've learned a bit more about different career options, here are some things you can do next:

- 1. Think about your school subjects:** When you're choosing your options, pick subjects that might help you with the careers you liked. *Example: If you liked a career in technology, you might want to choose computing as one of your subjects.*
- 2. Ask your teacher or careers lead/advisor:** Talk to them about what you're interested in and ask what subjects could help you get started on that path. *Example: If you're interested in engineering, ask what skills you need and how to develop them.*
- 3. Research more:** If a career or job sounds interesting to you, take some time to find out more by asking adults at home or looking online. *Example: Look up what qualifications or training are needed for the career that caught your attention.*
